NEW CAR & COACH PARK FOR BRISTOL CITY FOOTBALL CLUB TRAINING GROUND AND QUEEN ELIZABETH'S HOSPITAL SCHOOL AT FAILAND

In 2008 Bristol City FC joined forces in partnership with Queen Elizabeth's Hospital School for a new £1m Training Ground at the school's existing premises alongside new land purchased by the school.

North Somerset Council approved plans to develop the ground and new complex for the benefit of QEH pupils and Bristol City FC.

As part of the development Ford Bros were awarded the contract to construct a new car and coach park.

In keeping with the high quality of the facilities being developed, above standard parking facilities have been provided in a user friendly and safe environment.



Works included traditional Macadam surfacing for both construction and improvements to the entrances and roadways. The parking areas were constructed of Plastic Cellular Grass Reinforcement Units filled with clean sand. These units provided a free-draining surface for prevention of flood.

The project was completed on schedule for Bristol FC players to use for the first time early in September 2008.
